BRSC Sailing Course Level Four

For the Blue Pennant Award you must:

Be able to tie a bowline

Be able to rig and launch a dinghy without assistance in an onshore wind

Be able to sail up to a jetty or moored boat and to come along side without assistance

Be proficient at sailing a single-handed dinghy alone in up to a force 4 wind

Be able to sail any race course set in inshore waters and to round racing marks on the tack and on the gybe

Know the basic rules of sailing and the essential racing rules

Be able to identify the signal pennant flag "Blue Peter"

Be able to right a capsized dinghy efficiently, bail out and sail on and organise the boat for a rescue tow

Be able to return an optimist or scow to shore with no sails and no more than one oar or paddle

Be able to anchor a dinghy with the wind and against the tide

Be able to sail up to and secure to a mooring buoy with the wind and against the tide
