BRSC Sailing Course Level Two

For the Red Pennant Award you must:

- Be able to rig a dinghy unassisted
- Be able to tie a round turn and two half hitches
- Be able to get underway from and return to a beach or pontoon (offshore wind)
- Be able to right single-handed a capsized dinghy
- Be able to go about (close reach to close reach)
- Be able to get out of "irons"
- Be able to crew a dinghy effectively ie adjust sails, centreboard and body weight)
- Be able to sail a figure of eight course across the wind under supervision
- Be able to stop a dinghy by lying-to
- Be aware of what is meant by a gybe
- Be able to "spill" the wind
- Be able to row a reasonable distance
- Know what is meant by port and starboard
- Know how to prepare for a multiple tow
- Know how to be aware of wind and tidal conditions (ie forecast, tide tables, etc)
