Tide Times – Please refer to the Club website or the Admiralty Easy Tide website for tide times and detailed tidal predictions.

Racing Instructions – Please refer to the Club website for the current RYA-approved racing guidance under which the BRSC organises and manages races.

Start Times – The Officer of the Day will attempt to start the first race at the time stated in the programme. In the event of adverse weather, the organiser or class captain will try and give 24hrs notice of any cancellation; however events may be cancelled on the day any time before the start.

Important Information

Personal Buoyancy – All sailors and helpers must wear suitable personal buoyancy when afloat.

Liability – Sailors are responsible for their own safety and that of their boat. The Club cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury whilst taking part in programmed events.

Boat Maintenance – Sailors must ensure that their boats are properly maintained and fit for the conditions including suitable buoyancy & reefing points.

The Officer of the Day reserves the right to stop any unseaworthy boat from racing.

Insurance – All sailors are to ensure that their boats have adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2m. Please note, if you lend your boat, you could still be responsible for settling claims made against you.

Safety Cover – Reasonable efforts will be made to provide adequate safety boat cover, sailors are reminded that, particularly in extreme weather conditions, cover should not be relied upon and in any event they can only be given such assistance as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

End of Season – Please remove boats and your sailing equipment from Needs Ore and Needs Ore sail locker by 26 Oct and Rope Factory Field and Rope Factory Field donkey hut by 9 Nov. Any boat or equipment left behind will be deemed to be abandoned and is liable to be disposed of by the Boatswain.
